1 x 2.4 by 1.2 Corflute

1 x 1.2 by 1.2 Corflute

1 x roll of duct tape

1 x Crafting 'knife'

Utilising these materials ONLY you must make a boat and paddle that will be able to support an 'adult' 16 yrs + to paddle a course running parallel to the Russell Beach front – From the cannon to the wharf.

Rules

- Only materials listed above can be used to make your vessel and paddle
- The signwriting on the corflute must be on the outside of the vessel easy to read.
- Boats will be judged at 12.30pm on the beach front where building is taking place.
- Water guns / flour bombs can be used for the race – bumping and pushing allowed but paddlers must not get out of their vessel to sabotage others vessels.
- The winner will be first under the wharf still in their vessel
- All participants must wear a life jacket.
